Thousands of professionals and caregivers have embraced the SIVA model as their training program of choice. SIVA has been described as "a refreshing alternative to crisis focused programs." SIVA is recognized by the Canadian Accreditation Council and agencies who have completed C.A.R.F. (Commission of Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities) accreditation have received an exemplary designation for their use of the SIVA program.
